Australian Packaging Covenant Industry Classifications and Contributions

Brand Owner / Packaging user (Contribution Classification G) is *any* of the following:

- A person who is the owner of licensee in Australia of a trade mark under which a product is sold or otherwise distributed in Australia, whether the trade mark is registered or not
- A person who is the franchisee in Australia of a business arrangement which allows an individual, partnership, or company to operate under the name of an already established business
- In the case of a product which has been imported, the first person to sell that product in Australia
- In respect of in-store packaging, the supplier of the packaging to the store
- In respect to plastic bags, the importer or manufacturer of the plastic bag or the retailer who provides the plastic bag to the consumer for the transportation of products purchased by the consumer at the point of sale

Packaging Related Turnover represents total sales of packaged finished goods sold into the consumer market place in Australia, including industrial applications and sales for public events e.g. for sporting events.

Raw material supplier (Contribution Classification G): A company that supplies raw materials to companies that manufacture product packaging.

Packaging Related Turnover represents total sales of raw materials used in the manufacture of consumer packaging in Australia, including industrial packaging.

Packaging manufacturer/supplier (Contribution Classification PM): A company that manufactures or supplies packaging materials.

Packaging Related Turnover represents total sales of packaging sold in Australia.

Wholesaler Retailer (Contribution Classification G): A company involved in wholesaling or retailing of consumer packaged products.

Packaging Related Turnover represents total sales of packaged finished goods in Australia.

Waste Management and other commercial organisations (Contribution Classification G): A waste management organisation and any other commercial enterprise that does not fall into the above categories will be required to pay based on the organisation's packaging related turnover, and in any case must pay the minimum general rate (Classification G).

Packaging Related Turnover represents the dollar value per annum of contracts and agreements that are attributable to the collection of consumer packaging and for the collection of paper from households.

Other: Organisations such as Industry associations, community groups and local government associations will be required to pay a standard fixed amount of \$110 including GST to join the Australian Packaging Covenant.

It is important to note that:

- Imports are to be included in calculations at the point of entry into the Australian supply chain.
- Only sales for packaging-related activities should be included.
- Export sales are excluded.
- Companies that come under several classifications can contribute under the classification applicable to the dominant portion of their business if that portion represents 80 per cent or more of the company turnover. If this is not the case, contributions need to be calculated for each segment of the company's business according to the portion of the total turnover applicable to each classification.
